## PrSandoz® Tramadol

Dear customer,

Sandoz Canada Inc. would like to inform you of an upcoming schedule change affecting PrSandoz® Tramadol. In compliance with a Health Canada decision, and **effective March 31<sup>st</sup> 2022**, tramadol hydrochloride tablets of 50 mg will be removed from the *Canadian Prescription Drug List* and scheduled under the *Controlled Drugs and Substances Act*.

Sandoz product DIN, format and UPC will remain unchanged but a new packaging will be introduced with the name <sup>N</sup>Sandoz® Tramadol to reflect the schedule change.

**You must deplete your current product inventory before ordering new ones.**

However, as of March 31<sup>st</sup> 2022, tramadol hydrochloride tablets of 50 mg must be handled as narcotic products.
